Vineyard: Spanish Springs
AVA: SLO Coast AVA
Clones: Swan, #667 and 2A

Rootstock: 101-14 Year Planted: 2007

Soil Info: Pismo sandy loam and Lopez shale clay laom.

Spanish Springs Vineyard is one of the closest vineyards to the Pacific Ocean in California. It sits 2 miles inland from Pismo Beach. This site produces wines with great structure and ample amounts of acidity. We work with three different clones to create our vineyard designate Pinot Noir. This vineyard is SIP certified (Sustainable in Practice).

WINEMAKING INFORMATION:

Harvest Date: Hand harvested early morning of September 21st and 26th, 2020

Brix: 24.5-25.5 at harvest Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir

Clonal Blend: 43% #667, 43% Swan & 14% 2A

100% destemmed, native fermentation in 1.5 ton fermentors 5 day cold soak

16-18 days on the skins, then pressed into barrel

Barrel Age: Aged II months in French oak barrels. 30% New French Oak, 35%

I year old French oak and 35% seasoned French oak barrels.

Bottled: September 3rd, 2021

Alcohol: 14.4%

Production: 7 barrels - 152 Cases
