Vineyard: Rincon Vineyard AVA: Arroyo Grande Valley

Clone: 2A, Block 10 and Pommard Block 302

Rootstock: 101-14 **Year Planted:** 2000 & 2016

Soil Info: Consists of shallow soils with a mix of loam and calcareous clay

The Rincon Vineyard is the home vineyard where Don Talley planted the first vines of Talley Vineyards in 1982 and where the winery is located. Consisiting of two hillsides rising from the floor of the Arroyo Grande Valley, the clay calcarious soils of the West Rincon Vineyard yield wines with distinctive mineral and iron notes. This vineyard is SIP certified (Sustainable in Practice).

WINEMAKING INFORMATION:

Harvest Date: Hand harvested early morning of September 10th and 15th, 2020

Brix: 23.5-25

Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir

Colonal Blend: 60% 2A and 40% Pommard

100% destemmed, native fermentation in 1.5 ton fermentors

5 day cold soak

15 days on the skins, then pressed into barrel.

Barrel Age: Aged II months in French oak barrels. 20% new oak, 40% I year

old barrel, 40% seasoned French oak barrels.

Bottled: Steptember 3rd, 2021

Alcohol: 13.7%

Production: 5 barrels -115 cases
